





Kindergarten Supply List


- 1 Box of crayons (A box of 8 with only the primary colors are BEST!) If you can't find them you may get a box of 16 or 24. No large boxes please!)

Pesticide Notice

July 1, 2020

Dear Parents, Guardians and School Staff:

NYS Education Law Section 409-H, effective July 1, 2001, requires all public and non-public elementary and secondary schools to provide written notification to all persons in parental relation, faculty, and staff regarding the potential use of pesticides periodically throughout the school year.

The following pesticide application(s) took place:

As a reminder, Crown Point Central School is required to maintain a list of persons in parental relation, faculty, and staff who wish to receive 48-hour prior written notification of certain pesticide applications. The following pesticide applications are not subject to prior notification requirement.

The school remains unoccupied for a continuous 72 hours following the application of a pesticide that would otherwise dictate the use of a 48-hour notification.

Anti-microbial products; non-volatile rodenticides in tamper-resistant bait stations in areas inaccessible to children.

Non-volatile insecticidal baits in tamper-resistant bait stations in areas inaccessible to children.

Silica gels and other non-volatile, ready-to-use pastes, foams, or gels in areas inaccessible to children.

Boric acid and disodium octaborate tetra hydrate.

The application of EPA designated biopesticides.

The application of EPA designated exempt materials under 40CFR152.25.

The use of aerosol products with a directed spray in containers of 18 fluid ounces or less when used to protect individuals from an imminent threat from stinging and biting insects including venomous spiders, bees, wasps, and hornets.

In the event of an emergency application necessary to protect against an imminent threat to human health, a Good Faith effort will be made to supply written notification to those on the 48-hour Prior Notification List. If you would like to receive 48-hour prior notification of pesticide applications that are scheduled to occur in our school buildings, please complete the enclosed form and return it to John Bezon, IPM Coordinator, Crown Point Central School, P.O. Box 35, Crown Point, NY 12928.


