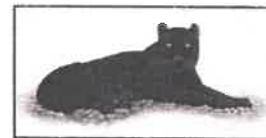

Last Friday, March 27<sup>th</sup>, Governor Andrew Cuomo announced that all public schools in New York State will remain closed until April 15<sup>th</sup>. This new Executive Order 202.11 supersedes all previous notifications. We will follow this order, and all subsequent orders, as set forth and continue to provide remote instruction, meals to students as well as child care for essential workers every weekday through April 14<sup>th</sup>.
