Mission Statement:

Crown Point Central School is an active school family working and growing together in an open, nurturing environment. Our aim is to instill in each child a desire to achieve high standards of excellence, social, emotional and physical skills. These goals will enable students to function as contributing members of society.

Community: As a small, rural community Crown Point, founded in 1786, located on the western shore of Lake Champlain and the base of the Adirondack Mountains is rich in history. Located just west from the center of town is the hamlet of Ironville, this *Historic District* is registered on the *National Register of Historic Places* and is the home of The *Penfield Homestead*. Crown Point is an original town within Essex County, NY, and home of the *Crown Point State Historic Site* (featuring the ruins of two forts from the colonial wars) as well as the *Champlain Memorial Lighthouse*. The Lake Champlain Bridge is another prominent landmark providing easy access to The State of Vermont. The town encompasses an area of approximately 82 square miles, having a population (in 2010) of approximately 2,024 people.

School: The Crown Point Central School District serves the educational needs for the community. *Home of the Panthers*, Crown Point Central School (CPCS) is a comprehensive PK-12 school, one building, housing a student population of approximately 325 students.

- CPCS operates using a block schedule consisting of 9- 40 minute class blocks.
- CPCS grading system is based on the 100 point scale.
- 90+ is High Honors, 84.5-89.9 is Honors, 65 is Passing
- Exceptional Honors=students earning 90+ in *all* courses within a quarter
- Students are evaluated on a quarterly basis.
- Grade Point Average (GPA) is unweighted.
- CPCS does not currently offer AP Courses, or High School Physics
- Average class size is 25 students.
- Career & Technical Education is via Champlain Valley Educational Services, CV-TEC.
